

GLCA Teaching Positions: FAQs

Who could fill these roles?

- Retired teachers
- Those with a teaching degree
- Those with teaching experience

Is this a paid position?

No, this is not a paid position, it is a missionary position where individuals raise their living expenses. However, housing and a vehicle are provided for the first year. The cost of living is very low here in Portugal, so many retired couples have found it to be very affordable.

Do I need to know or learn Portuguese?

No. There is a lot of English here in Lisbon, so you can get by with very minimal Portuguese.

What training would I need?

If you come with ABWE as a short term missionary, all the training can be done online before coming. We also have some of our teachers who come through Resourcing Christian Educators (RCE).

Do I need a visa?

Yes. We will help you with the application process.

Can I still come with COVID travel restrictions?

Yes. Even though tourists are not allowed, the government is still issuing longer term visas to allow for work related travel.

When would I need to come by?

School starts September 9th. Teachers would need to arrive by August 26th.

What about school breaks?

We have a 1 week break at Thanksgiving, a 2 week break at Christmas, 3 days at Carnival, and a 1 week Spring Break near Easter. Teachers are encouraged to enjoy that time off. Many of them travel around Europe or visit the USA during these school breaks.

Where is the teacher housing located?

Apartment options are located either on school property or within a few minutes drive.
